# Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil (one).

Last Sunday afternoon I met with the Board of Trustees of the Bergen County Islamic Center at 78 Trinity Place. They wanted to meet with religious leaders throughout the area on ways that we can all cooperate in making Bergen County a better place where the different faiths come together to do good for the neighborhood. They expected many but at the last minute many cancelled out and I was the only one to show. We talked about food pantries, interreligious gatherings like a picnic, etc. But of course my curiosity prompted me to ask about jihad. It seems so many Moslems are using jihad as the pretext for their terroristic activity. Mr. Jaheen explained that jihad is an internal struggle or fight against one's own evil desires and those who attack Islam or Moslems. I likened former thought to spiritual warfare.

As disciples of Christ, we are to resist the temptations and evil desires that come from our heart. As Jesus reminds us it is not what goes inside us that makes us evil, but what comes out from the heart – lust, greed, envy, pride, anger, gluttony, and sloth (see Mark 7:19). Yes, these 7 deadly or capital sins are what lead us into even greater sin, and we must be struggling with them otherwise we will lose the war. We too as Christians are at war with the flesh which desires that which is of the world as opposed to that which is of heaven. Constantly we must be on guard against the temptations and bad habits that lurk around us, like a lion poised to pounce the moment we forget that Jesus is with us and for us. (Be sober and vigilant. Your opponent the devil is prowling around like a roaring lion looking for (someone) to devour. Resist him, steadfast in faith (1 Peter 5:8)).

When those temptations come we need to call on Jesus and all the angels and saints without hesitation. The moment we hesitate is the moment we decide to give into the temptation. It is so incredibly simple to resist temptations yet how often we do fall. First we need to avoid the near occasion of sin. We make this promise each time we make a confession and pray the Our Father, *lead us not into temptation*. Also, when we are tempted we must call on the name of Jesus *to deliver us from evil* in these or similar words: I command you spirit of \_\_\_\_\_, in the name of Jesus go to hell. I pray this 3x in honor of the omnipotence of the Trinity. Many of us are accustomed to calling on St. Michael, God's defending angel to help us in our spiritual warfare:

*St. Michael the Archangel,  
defend us in battle.*

*Be our defense against the wickedness and snares of the Devil.*

*May God rebuke him, we humbly pray,  
and do thou,*

*O Prince of the heavenly hosts,  
by the power of God,  
thrust into hell Satan,  
and all the evil spirits,  
who prowl about the world  
seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.*

So in some way we all are fighting a jihad, not against infidels or people who offend our sensibilities, but rather in our struggle against sin, evil desires and temptation. Try calling on Jesus in your time of need and you will know the power of his Name.

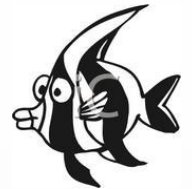

## De los sermones de San León Magno, papa



### DEL BIEN DE LA CARIDAD

Dice el Señor en el evangelio de Juan: La señal por la que conocerán todos que sois discípulos míos será que os amáis unos a otros; y en la carta del mismo apóstol se puede leer: Queridos, amémonos unos a otros, ya que el amor es de Dios, y todo el que ama ha nacido de Dios y conoce a Dios. Que los fieles abran de par en par sus mentes y traten de penetrar, con un examen verídico, los afectos de su corazón; si llegan a encontrar alguno de los frutos de la caridad escondido en sus conciencias, no duden de que tienen a Dios consigo, y, a fin de hacerse más capaces de acoger a tan excelso huésped, no dejen de multiplicar las obras de una misericordia perseverante. Pues, si Dios es amor, la caridad no puede tener fronteras, ya que la Divinidad no admite verse encerrada por ningún término. Los presentes días, queridísimos hermanos, son especialmente indicados para ejercitarse en la caridad —por más que no hay tiempo que no sea a propósito para ello—, quienes desean celebrar la Pascua del Señor con el cuerpo y el alma santificados deben poner especial empeño en conseguir, sobre todo, esta caridad, porque en ella se halla contenida la suma de todas las virtudes y con ella se cubre la muchedumbre de los pecados.

Por esto, al disponernos a celebrar aquel misterio que es el más eminente, con el que la sangre de Jesucristo borró nuestras iniquidades, comencemos por preparar ofrendas de misericordia, para conceder, por nuestra parte, a quienes pecaron contra nosotros lo que la bondad de Dios nos concedió a nosotros.

La largueza ha de extenderse ahora, con mayor benignidad, hacia los pobres y los impedidos por diversas debilidades, para que el agradecimiento a Dios brote de muchas bocas, y nuestros ayunos sirvan de sustento a los menesterosos. La devoción que más agrada a Dios es la de preocuparse de sus pobres, y, cuando Dios contempla el ejercicio de la misericordia, reconoce allí inmediatamente una imagen de su piedad. No hay por qué temer la disminución de los propios haberes con esas expensas, ya que la benignidad misma es una gran riqueza, ni puede faltar materia para la largueza allí donde Cristo apacienta y es apacentado. En toda esta faena interviene aquella mano que aumenta el pan cuando lo parte, y lo multiplica cuando lo da. Quien distribuye limosnas debe sentirse seguro y alegre, porque obtendrá la mayor ganancia cuando se haya quedado con el mínimo, según dice el bienaventurado apóstol Pablo: El que proporciona semilla para sembrar y pan para comer os proporcionará y aumentará la semilla, y multiplicará la cosecha de vuestra justicia en Cristo Jesús, Señor nuestro, que vive y reina con el Padre y el Espíritu Santo por los siglos de los siglos. Amén.
