**The Seven Sacraments: Life with Christ
 Baptism**

1281 Those who die for the faith, those who are catechumens, and all those who, without knowing of the Church but acting under the inspiration of grace, seek God sincerely and strive to fulfill his will, are saved even if they have not been baptized (cf. LG 16).

1282 Since the earliest times, Baptism has been administered to children, for it is a grace and a gift of God that does not presuppose any human merit; children are baptized in the faith of the Church. Entry into Christian life gives access to true freedom.

1283 With respect to children who have died without Baptism, the liturgy of the Church invites us to trust in God's mercy and to pray for their salvation.

1284 In case of necessity, any person can baptize provided that he have the intention of doing that which the Church does and provided that he pours water on the candidate's head while saying: "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

THE VALUE OF THE CHRISTIAN FAMILY

We are at a point in history where globalization, war between nations, poverty, environmental damage and other realities seem to be the only thing that counts in the media. These realities have made us lose our attention in our values as people and the importance of the family in this world. The family as the first manifestation of society is the basis of the teachings for a better future, and will continue to be the hope of a better world.

Although it seems that what we conceive as family is tending to disappear, I dare say that this will not happen, because there is no human group capable of replacing its important functions. There have been changes and there will be more and more realities that erase our idea of the scheme of the traditional family. It is now common to see single parent families. There are also the nuclear family (the basic triad of mother-father-children), the extended family (mother, father, children, grandparents, uncles), and the blended-family where a parent is raising his spouse's children of previous marriages and other situations in which children grow up alone, without the blessings of father or mother.

The family is and will remain the vital nucleus of society. That is why it has a great value for everyone. Therefore it is necessary to be aware that the value of the family depends on the quality of its members, the affections that makes it stay united, the union that it presents and its social integration through moral values.

As Christian families, it is important to keep in mind that the example of the parents has a more powerful effect than one thinks. That is why the call is for parents to be more responsible in the education in their homes. Today, a greater effort is required in a comprehensive education. As fathers and mothers we not only have to worry about giving our children a purely intellectual education, we must also give them the basis of the religion, that is, transmit and teach them faith. The same faith that perhaps many of us received in our home.

In the family, religion is to raise children in discipline and with the meaning of God in their lives. To teach the children that God Himself is a family (Father, Son and Holy Spirit.) That as a family we form the first church, the domestic church. The family is a community of faith, hope and charity. That's why we can call it the domestic Church.

The Christian family is a communion of persons, which reflects the communion that exists in God between the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The family not only reflects the union within the Holy Trinity, but also shares with God the creative work, in procreating and educating the children. That is why the family has the mission to evangelize; to its own children and to all

those around it.

The Christian family is called to prayer. We pray together to God, who has created the family. Thus, a family that prays together will remain united. With daily prayer and talking with God at all times, it will strengthen the union and love that exists between family members. And if a family is united with God by means of prayer, it will be lived continuously. If God is present, the members of the family will be a reflection of the love of God.

With God present in a Christian family, we contemplate the hope of a better world, because when God lives in a family, happiness abounds not only in its members, but in everyone around it.

IS YOUR MARRIAGE A VALID SACRAMENT?

If you were married civilly, that is not in the Catholic Church before a priest or deacon, it is not a valid sacramental marriage. This is an impediment to receiving the Eucharist and other sacraments. For a marriage to be valid in the Catholic Church, the marriage must be in a Catholic Church or Chapel and officiated by an authorized Catholic priest or deacon along with 2 witnesses. (There are limited interfaith exceptions with proper permission.)

I invite you to speak with one of our priests if there are any questions or if indeed you wish to validate your marriage. The process can be very simple and your marriage will now be blessed by the Church. Once the Marriage is validated, that is blessed in the Church, you will be able to receive the Eucharist, make Sacramental Confession, and receive the other sacraments.

EL VALOR DE LA FAMILIA CRISTIANA

Nos encontramos en un momento de la historia donde la globalización, la guerra entre naciones, la pobreza, el daño del medio ambiente y otras realidades parecieran ser lo único que cuenta en los medios de comunicación. Realidades que nos han hecho perder la atención en nuestros valores como personas y la importancia de la familia dentro este mundo. La familia como primera manifestación de sociedad es la base de las enseñanzas para un mejor futuro, es y seguirá siendo la esperanza de un mundo mejor.

Aunque pareciera que lo que concebimos como familia tiende a desaparecer, me atrevería a decir que esto no va a pasar, pues no existe un grupo humano capaz de sustituir sus importantes funciones. Ha habido cambios y habrá cada vez más realidades que borren nuestra idea del esquema de la familia tradicional. Los Siete Sacramentos: Vida con Cristo Bautismo

1281 Los que padecen la muerte a causa de la fe, los catecúmenos y todos los hombres que, bajo el impulso de la gracia, sin conocer la Iglesia, buscan sinceramente a Dios y se esfuerzan por cumplir su voluntad, pueden salvarse aunque no hayan recibido el Bautismo (cf LG 16).

1282 Desde los tiempos más antiguos, el Bautismo es dado a los niños, porque es una gracia y un don de Dios que no suponen méritos humanos; los niños son bautizados en la fe de la Iglesia. La entrada en la vida cristiana da acceso a la verdadera libertad.

1283 En cuanto a los niños muertos sin bautismo, la liturgia de la Iglesia nos invita a tener confianza en la misericordia divina y a orar por su salvación.

1284 En caso de necesidad, toda persona puede bautizar, con tal que tenga la intención de hacer lo que hace la Iglesia, y que derrame agua sobre la cabeza del candidato diciendo: "Yo te bautizo en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo".
