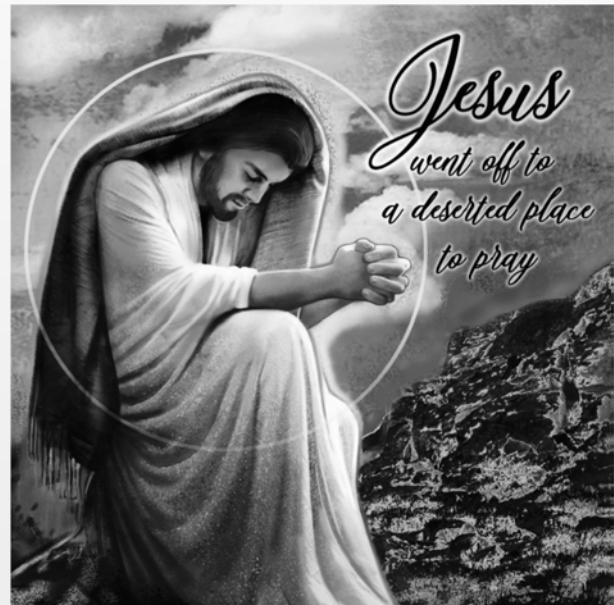

TIRELESS DISCIPLESHIP

The stories we've been hearing these weeks come from the very first chapter of Mark, and they show us the public ministry of Jesus in its infancy. Today's account shows some of the strain or adjustment of his new life of preaching the reign of God, healing the sick, and casting out demons. Notice that after sunset, when darkness ended the workday, people brought the sick and possessed to Jesus. The following day he rose before dawn



to get away by himself to pray, but to no avail. Simon Peter and the others don't just look for him, they pursue him, filled with the fervor that his ministry has incited. With the self-sacrificing example he gave until the end of his earthly life, he tells his followers that this is his whole purpose. Through Mark, he is also telling the early church, and he is telling us, that this is our purpose, our vocation: to be tireless in our pursuit of proclaiming the Good News, and in bringing the healing, reconciling touch of Christ to the world.

Como Católicos, estamos llamados a servir al prójimo con compasión y humildad. El Llamado Anual Compartiendo las Bendiciones de Dios ofrece a cada uno de nosotros la oportunidad de compartir las angustias sufridas por nuestros hermanos y hermanas en Cristo financiando ministerios y programas que proporcionan apoyo social, educativo y espiritual a miles de personas cada año. ¡Su generosidad con el Llamado Anual Compartiendo las Bendiciones de Dios es muy apreciada!

¿Cómo sirve el Llamado Anual a nuestra comunidad?

Educación y Formación de Seminaristas: La Arquidiócesis ha sido bendecida con tres seminarios. El Llamado Anual apoya los costos de la educación y la formación de nuestros futuros sacerdotes. En los últimos 10 años, 125 hombres han sido ordenados al sacerdocio.

Caridades Católicas: Cada año Caridades Católicas de la Arquidiócesis de Newark ayuda a más de 80,000 personas con alimentos, ropa,

refugio, educación especial y programas sociales desde locales alrededor de los cuatro condados que servimos. Esto incluye las 52,000 personas atendidas a través de la Red de Comedores de Emergencia Alimentaria y Nutrición y las cerca de 6,000 personas que fueron colocadas en residencias temporales mientras buscaban empleos y que fueron capaces de volver a levantarse.

Parroquias: La Arquidiócesis de Newark está compuesta por 214 parroquias vibrantes dentro de los condados de Bergen, Essex, Hudson y Union. Varias parroquias reciben asistencia financiera que las ayuda a mantener sus puertas abiertas. Además, aquellas parroquias que sobrepasan la meta de su Llamado Anual, reciben un reembolso que puede ser utilizado para mejorar ministerios, hacer reparaciones o ayudar a los necesitados en la parroquia.

Pastoral Juvenil: Oficina de Pastoral Juvenil y de Jóvenes Adultos ofrecen a los jóvenes la oportunidad de asistir a retiros y aumentar su conocimiento de la Fe Católica. Para los padres que trabajan, el campamento de verano diario ofrece un lugar para que los niños participen en actividades deportivas y artesanía.

Jubilación de Sacerdotes: Después de dedicar sus vidas a la Iglesia, muchos sacerdotes jubilados continúan sirviendo a la gente de nuestra comunidad. Actualmente nos ocupamos de casi 200 sacerdotes jubilados que han servido fielmente a la Iglesia. El Llamado Anual complementa el costo de mantenimiento de nuestras dos casas de retiro para sacerdotes - la Casa St. John Vianney y la Residencia Msgr. Kelly.

Pastoral Universitaria: Ministerios Universitarios están ubicados en diez universitarios a través de la Arquidiócesis y se encargan de la tarea de llevar nuestra Fe a miles de estudiantes de edad universitaria. Estos ministerios universitarios ayudan a conectar jóvenes con su Fe y traer a otros a la Fe Católica a través de retiros, eventos especiales, y el Rito de Iniciación Cristiana de Adultos.
