**Life with Christ: The Creed**

**Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our LORD**

**CHRIST DESCENDED INTO HELL**

636 By the expression "He descended into hell", the Apostles' Creed confesses that Jesus did really die and through his death for us conquered death and the devil "who has the power of death" (Heb 2:14).

637 In his human soul united to his divine person, the dead Christ went down to the realm of the dead. He opened heaven's gates for the just who had gone before him.

**ON THE THIRD DAY HE ROSE FROM THE DEAD**

656 Faith in the Resurrection has as its object an event which as historically attested to by the disciples, who really encountered the Risen One. At the same time, this event is mysteriously transcendent insofar as it is the entry of Christ's humanity into the glory of God.

657 The empty tomb and the linen cloths lying there signify in themselves that by God's power Christ's body had escaped the bonds of death and corruption. They prepared the disciples to encounter the Risen Lord.

658 Christ, "the first-born from the dead" (Col 1:18), is the principle of our own resurrection, even now by the justification of our souls (Rom 6:4), and one day by the new life he will impart to our bodies (Rom 8:11).

Saturday, April 28 we surprised Sr. Emily Walsh, SC with the dedication of Maple Avenue as **Sister Emily's Way**. She was in such disbelief and declared she was at a loss for words but nonetheless spoke of her gratefulness for the honor and her love of the Parish for 10 minutes. I added these following words to express our appreciation for her 51 years of mission at Holy Trinity Church and her 80 years as a religious.

Today is a special day not only for Holy Trinity Church but for the entire City of Hackensack. We are here for the one person who is special to everyone that is here present and who would have loved to have been here. And that person is Jesus Christ.

And the reason we're honoring Sister Emily is because she has been such a tangible example to us of her Lord. Christ asked us to feed the hungry and give drink to the thirsty. For decades Sister Emily ran the St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry which still continues to touch many hearts (and stomachs).

Christ instructed us to visit the sick & comfort the afflicted. How often Sister Emily became the friend of those confined to the home, of those recuperating in the hospital and rehab centers, and of those retired to the assisted living residences. Whenever I had an open day, Sister Emily would take me on her visits to bring comfort, a kind presence and of course the Body of Christ.

Christ charged us to bury the dead. Sister Emily with due diligence helped families prepare their loved one's funeral and visited the mourners. Today we have followed her footsteps in being there for the sorrowing families and widows.

Christ commanded us to instruct the ignorant. When Sister Emily first arrived in this fabled city, she took over the school to educate children in faith and reason. The number of children that she educated is innumerable and the effect she had on them incalculable.

Sister Emily has been Christ's instrument of mercy for over 50 years in this parish, & in this city, and it is no small wonder that we now honor her as Christ's faithful witness and a true citizen of Hackensack, by dedicating this street – **Sister Emily's Way** – to be ever remembered in the hearts of all who know her.

### **TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE**

Durante la Última Cena, Jesús dijo a sus apóstoles: "Yo soy la vid, ustedes son los sarmientos" (Juan 15:5). Jesús añade que los sarmientos (ramas) que permanecen en él, dan mucho fruto. Según la agricultura, la vid es una parra, es decir, una planta perenne de ramas frondosas.

Una parte importante de la vid son las hojas. Es obvio que una vid tiene hojas, pero Jesús no las menciona, prefiere enfocarse en los sarmientos. Las partes de la vid son las raíces, tronco, sarmientos, hojas, flores y fruto. Según esta división Jesús sería el tronco, pero él dice ser la vid completa. Esta es una imagen de la unidad que Jesús quiere entre sus seguidores. Recordemos que Jesús celebra la Última Cena con sus discípulos. La comunidad de discípulos unidos a Jesús formamos la vid. Los sarmientos o ramas conducen agua y minerales a las hojas, flores y frutos, y son útiles en tanto estén unidos a la vid. Lo mismo vale de los cristianos, discípulos de Jesús. Son ellos y ellas los que hacen presente y le dan vida a Jesús en el mundo de hoy.
