**Life with Christ: The Creed
The Holy Catholic Church**

“I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY CATHOLIC CHURCH”

748 "Christ is the light of humanity; and it is, accordingly, the heart-felt desire of this sacred Council, being gathered together in the Holy Spirit, that, by proclaiming his Gospel to every creature, it may bring to all men that light of Christ which shines out visibly from the Church."

These words open the Second Vatican Council's Dogmatic Constitution on the Church. By choosing this starting point, the Council demonstrates that the article of faith about the Church depends entirely on the articles concerning Christ Jesus. the Church has no other light than Christ's; according to a favorite image of the Church Fathers, the Church is like the moon, all its light reflected from the sun.

749 The article concerning the Church also depends entirely on the article about the Holy Spirit, which immediately precedes it. "Indeed, having shown that the Spirit is the source and giver of all holiness, we now confess that it is he who has endowed the Church with holiness." The Church is, in a phrase used by the Fathers, the place "where the Spirit flourishes."

750 To believe that the Church is "holy" and "catholic," and that she is "one" and "apostolic" (as the Nicene Creed adds), is inseparable from belief in God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. In the Apostles' Creed we profess "one Holy Church" (Credo . . . Ecclesiam), and not to believe in the Church, so as not to confuse God with his works and to attribute clearly to God's goodness all the gifts he has bestowed on his Church.

HOW TO RECEIVE REVERENTLY

1. Receive in the state of Grace. If you are aware of having committed grave sin, you must make a Sacramental confession before receiving.
2. Approach the Altar modestly. Scantly dressed is a sign of irreverence of both your neighbor and of God.
3. Before stepping up, bow your head and say, "AMEN" when the minister says, "The Body/Blood of Christ."
4. Put one hand into your dominant hand to receive the Sacred Species. Stepping aside, take the Communion with the dominant hand and eat it immediately. Don't lap it up with your tongue. Don't grab the Host from the minister.
5. By mouth: Step up and open your mouth wide enough to receive on the tongue. Do not grab it with your teeth or lips. Do not lurch forward as if to grab it; Receive the Lord Precious Blood: Receive the Chalice and take a small drink; neither a whiff nor as if to whet your lips only.
7. Return quietly to your pew and make a prayer of thanksgiving.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The origins of today's solemnity lie in thirteenth-century Belgium. In those days, people seldom received Holy Communion, and never from the chalice. A nun in a troubled convent, Juliana of Liège, devoted her life to stirring up love for the Eucharist, lobbying for a feast day to honor the Blessed Sacrament with Masses and processions.

Juliana may have been inspired by the Ascension Day processions in nearby Bruges. Crusaders brought a treasure home to Bruges from Constantinople in 1204: a reliquary containing a cloth from Joseph of Arimathea with which he had helped prepare the body of Jesus for burial. The stain on the cloth was said to be the holy blood itself, and so the people of Bruges built a great basilica to house the relic. Bruges became a great center of pilgrimage because of this treasure, and the procession of the Holy Blood is still one of the greatest festivals in Belgium today. The bishop carries the relic through the narrow streets, and the people wear medieval costumes and act out scenes from the Bible.

Vida con Cristo: El Credo La Santa Iglesia Católica

“CREO EN LA SANTA IGLESIA CATÓLICA”

748 "Cristo es la luz de los pueblos. Por eso, este sacrosanto Sínodo, reunido en el Espíritu Santo, desea vehementemente iluminar a todos los hombres con la luz de Cristo, que resplandece sobre el rostro de la Iglesia (LG 1), anunciando el Evangelio a todas las criaturas". Con estas palabras comienza la "Constitución dogmática sobre la Iglesia" del Concilio Vaticano II. Así, el Concilio muestra que el artículo de la fe sobre la Iglesia depende enteramente de los artículos que se refieren a Cristo Jesús. La Iglesia no tiene otra luz que la de Cristo; ella es, según una imagen predilecta de los Padres de la Iglesia, comparable a la luna cuya luz es reflejo del sol.

749 El artículo sobre la Iglesia depende enteramente también del que le precede, sobre el Espíritu Santo. "En efecto, después de haber mostrado que el Espíritu Santo es la fuente y el dador de toda santidad, confesamos ahora que es Él quien ha dotado de santidad a la Iglesia" (Catecismo Romano, 1, 10, 1). La Iglesia, según la expresión de los Padres, es el lugar "donde florece el Espíritu" (San Hipólito Romano).

750 Creer que la Iglesia es "Santa" y "Católica", y que es "Una" y "Apostólica" es inseparable de la fe en Dios, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Los cristianos creemos que Jesucristo está físicamente presente en el pan y el vino consagrado durante la Misa. Esta creencia es tan antigua como nuestra Iglesia, pero fue solo en el siglo XIII que los cristianos comenzaron a venerar la presencia sacramentada de Jesús en la hostia. Fue durante esta época que nació la fiesta de Corpus Christi o la actual celebración del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Muchas comunidades cristianas celebran esta fiesta con procesiones y cantos en honor al Santísimo Sacramento del altar.

Recuerdo que en Texas el pueblo mexicano cantaba: "Bendito, bendito, bendito sea Dios, / los ángeles cantan y alaban a Dios (2x). Yo creo Dios mío que estas en el altar / oculto en la hostia ten vengo adorar (2x)". Este canto enfatiza la verdadera presencia de Jesús en el pan consagrado, pero sus cantores ignoran el hecho que nosotros también fuimos consagrados en el Bautismo; consagrados para "alter Christus" (otro Cristo) en el vecindario. En un mundo donde menos gente asiste a Misa el único Corpus Christi que la mayoría de la gente secularizada verá es tu cuerpo. Ojalá podamos comportarnos como buenos testigos de la fe y que proclamemos "bendito, bendito" siempre y en todo lugar.
