**Life with Christ:
The Lord's Prayer**

SUMMARY OF THE WHOLE GOSPEL

2773 In response to his disciples' request "Lord, teach us to pray" (Lk 11:1), Jesus entrusts them with the fundamental Christian prayer, the Our Father.

2774 "The Lord's Prayer is truly the summary of the whole gospel," The "most perfect of prayers." It is at the center of the Scriptures.

2775 It is called "the Lord's Prayer" because it comes to us from the Lord Jesus, the master and model of our prayer.

2776 The Lord's Prayer is the quintessential prayer of the Church. It is an integral part of the major hours of the Divine Office and of the sacraments of Christian initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. Integrated into the Eucharist it reveals the eschatological character of its petitions, hoping for the Lord, "until he comes" (1 Cor 11:26).

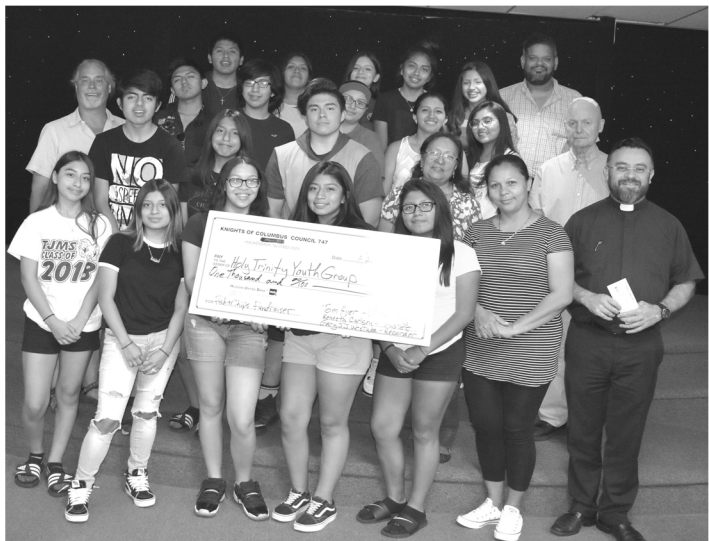

It's one of those words which often makes us shrink. After all, who wants to be humble or even humiliated? But it is a virtue, something we ought to desire and practice. CS Lewis said: True humility is not thinking less of yourself, but rather it is thinking of yourself less. Take this simple test to see if you lack humility or overflow with it. The next time you go to the parking lot and are searching for a place to park, which spot do you take? The one nearest the entrance of the store or the one further away?

When we can love our neighbor as ourselves or when we can defer to the one we love, or simply give the better parking spot to a stranger, then we can say with all humility, but not too loudly: I have practiced the virtue of humility with all grace. Remember Jesus is our prime example of humility for though he was in the form of God he humbled himself and took the form of a slave (see Philippians 2:1-11).

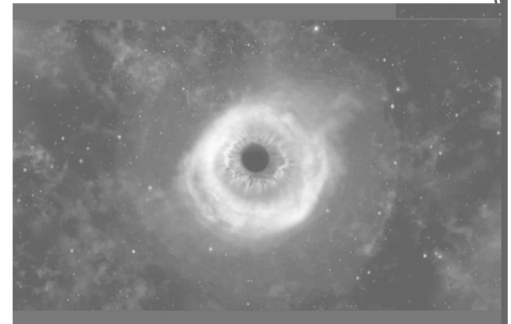

2774 “La oración del Señor o dominical es, en verdad, el resumen de todo el Evangelio” (Tertuliano, De oratione, 1, 6), “la más perfecta de las oraciones” (Santo Tomás de Aquino, Summa. theologiae 2-2, q. 83, a. 9). Es el corazón de las Sagradas Escrituras.

2775 Se llama “Oración dominical” porque nos viene del Señor Jesús, Maestro y modelo de nuestra oración.

2776 La Oración dominical es la oración por excelencia de la Iglesia. Forma parte integrante de las principales Horas del Oficio divino y de los sacramentos de la iniciación cristiana: Bautismo, Confirmación y Eucaristía. Inserta en la Eucaristía, manifiesta el carácter “escatológico” de sus peticiones, en la esperanza del Señor, “hasta que venga” (1 Co 11, 26).
