Where is God? St. Augustine looked for God for many years before he found Him. The reason for this is that he was looking in all the wrong places. It wasn't until he looked within that he found his Maker, his Love. By plunging into the things God created, he enjoyed only the loveliness of God's creation but not God. He was blind to the reality that underpinned the creation. Eventually God broke through Augustine's deafness and blindness and Augustine knew God.

Likewise we often are looking for God on the outside rather than looking in. We expect to see saints, experience miracles, and find perfection in others and in things, in other words on the outside. But the truth is, the world as lovely as it can be is not God, our fellow human being is not God, and even the miracles are not God. We cannot know God until we sit down and are silent, and then God will speak to our hearts and reveal himself to us. We know of (*scio*) God through his creation and our senses, but we know (*cognosco*) God when we encounter Him in the silence of our heart.

Last Monday I spent 3 hours on the phone speaking to friends and priests about the latest scandals: from child abuse allegations 50 years old to the hierarchy, including the Pope, who have or may have covered up, protected or ignored deviant priests and bishops. What is a Catholic faithful to do? My response was to keep on doing what you are doing. Go to Mass, make confession, say your prayers, and teach your children well. Jesus clearly stated: *Do as they say, not as they do*. If our bishops are teaching the Catholic faith then be obedient to the teaching (the *depositum fidei*) even if they have sinned, erred or have just been humanly fallible. We ought not worship, adore or see God in these men. Though they stand in *persona Christi* in our celebration of the Sacraments, they are still human beings, sons of mothers and fathers from our community. If God calls you to say something, the Holy Spirit will give you the words to say, otherwise be still in the presence of God and let Him speak peace to your heart.

The Church has gone through greater scandals than this and has always come out all the more holy for it is her nature to be the unblemished bride of Christ whom He loves with love beyond all telling. Jesus told the religious leaders of his time, "Cleanse first the inside of the cup, so that the outside may also be clean." Once our leaders return to the presence of God (Please note most bishops and priests are striving to live holy lives, even though what we hear sounds universally true of all clergy, it is only applicable to a few.) and know Him once more in the depths of their being, the Church (bruised saint and re-

pentant sinner alike) will be renewed. Many may have to be purged from their ranks, but this will be for the good. Remember this is Christ's Church and the gates of hell will never prevail against her. God can take any evil man does and turn it to good; just look at the cross and you will understand this.

And let us pray. We call upon St. Joseph, the guardian of the Church and the Blessed Mother, the first disciple of Christ to intercede for us. May we repent of our own sins, ask God to forgive those who sin against us, especially against the most vulnerable. And may the Holy Spirit descend upon us, healing the wounds of abuse, corruption, pride and sexual impropriety.

En una ciudad de California, es ilegal tener dos bañeras dentro de una casa. Cuando se pasó la ley era un lujo tener acceso al agua corriente, pero ahora que no lo es la ley parece ridícula. Sin embargo, el valor humano de proteger y preservar los recursos más valiosos sigue teniendo vigencia, esto se manifiesta en muchas leyes, que nos parecen muy acertadas, cuyo fin es proteger el medio ambiente. Sucede lo mismo con los preceptos religiosos. 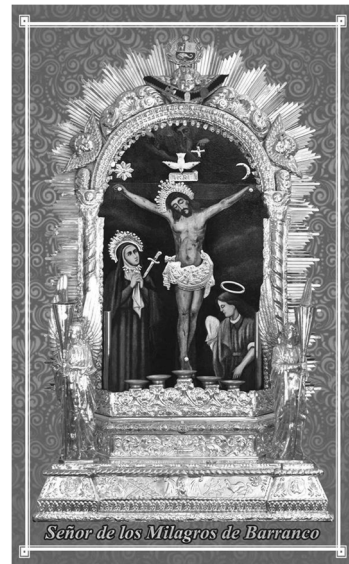
El Sacramento del Bautismo: Por favor llame para registrarse a su niño para el bautismo con anticipación.
