Over the past two weeks I have addressed the great scandal confronting the Church. She is at a great crossroad. Every few centuries this happens. I would say the last great crisis was the Reformation period of the Sixteenth and Seventeenth centuries. The Church rallied and convoked an ecumenical council at Trent, and so was born the Counter Reformation which stemmed the outward flow of Christians to Protestantism and many reverted to the one Church.

Today, we are confronting another crisis in which the young are falling away because they see the Church and Christ's teaching as irrelevant to their technological/scientific world. The Church is losing members by attrition. The recent scandal which goes back decades and has infiltrated the Church throughout gives only more credence to young persons' indifference to religion.

St. Michael the Archangel has a special heavenly role in doing battle against the devil, protecting the Church and her faithful against the assaults of the devil. In 1886, Pope Leo XIII following Holy Mass, received a vision in which he saw the great damage Satan would do to the Church and the world in the 20th century. Pope Leo then composed a prayer to St. Michael in response and added it to the prayers to be recited after Mass. Although no longer required to be said after Mass, the prayer is still encouraged.

Pope St. John Paul II said, "May prayer strengthen us for the spiritual battle that the Letter to the Ephesians speaks of: 'Be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might' (6:10). The Book of Revelation refers to this same battle, recalling before our eyes the image of St Michael the Archangel (cf. Revelation 12:7). Pope Leo XIII certainly had this picture in mind when, at the end of the last century, he brought in, throughout the Church, a special prayer to St Michael: 'Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil...' Although this prayer is no longer recited at the end of Mass, I ask everyone not to forget it and to recite it to obtain help in the battle against the forces of darkness and against the spirit of this world."

Keeping this in mind I will now ask all of us, if you please, to pray this prayer of St. Michael after every Mass after the final blessing. I hope to begin by September 30 (Sept 29 is the Feast of St. Michael).

Let us pray, For Holy Mother Church,
For the Victims of molestation,
For the Conversion of Sinners,
For the Leaders of the Church.

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him we humbly pray; and do thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the Power of God, cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits, who wander through the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

Mary, Mother of the Church...Pray for us.

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Este año hemos estado reflexionando sobre algunas tradiciones latinoamericanas de nuestra fe. Creo que sería bueno reflexionar también sobre lo que es la Tradición y lo que son las tradiciones. En muchas ocasiones durante mi formación religiosa mis maestros me advertían de no confundir la Tradición en mayúscula con la tradición en minúscula.

"¿Cuál es la diferencia?", preguntaba. Y de seguro algunos de ustedes se lo estarán preguntando también. Según el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (CIC 75-83) los Apóstoles transmitieron el Evangelio de Jesucristo de manera escrita y de manera oral. El Evangelio escrito nos ha llegado en forma del Nuevo Testamento, en especial por los cuatro evangelios. El Evangelio oral nos ha llegado por lo que llamamos la Tradición; ésta nos llega por la predicación, la vida y el ejemplo de los Apóstoles.

De esta Tradición o Evangelio oral nacen tradiciones teológicas, disciplinares, litúrgicas o devocionales para diversas escuelas espirituales o grupos étnicos y nacionales. Estas tradiciones necesitan medirse con la gran Tradición evangélica y sólo aquellas que animan a los fieles a vivir más de cerca el Evangelio deben ser promovidas.

Como Reportar Abuso

El Arquidiócesis toma seriamente cualquier y todas alegaciones de mala conducta sexual por miembros del clero, Religiosos y personal laico del Arquidiócesis.
