**R**ejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus. Do not quench the Spirit. (1 Thess 5:16-19)

The Christian spiritual life can be likened to three persons who invested in the stock market. The first man took \$500,000 and bought social media stock. The second woman took \$50,000 and invested it in tech stock. The third man was of humble means and could only invest \$5,000 in blue chip stock.

The first investor was excited, his investments grew rapidly, doubling, tripling even quadrupling. He became very rich. He now owned three homes, had servants and collected antique cars. Believing he was set for life he sat back on his laurels watching the money flow.

The second investor watched as her stock grew and yielded nice dividends. Technology was doing fantastically and she and her family enjoyed the benefits of the extra income. They were able to fund a second home on the shore, finance a SUV, and even hired someone to clean the house.

The third investor's stock yielded a modest dividend and the share value grew steadily but slowly. With his dividends, he was able to reinvest half and spend the other half on the simple pleasures of life and charity.

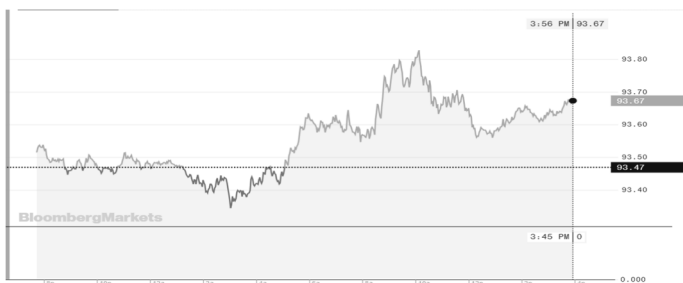
And then it happened. The market went wild. Suddenly it became a bear market, and the share values plummeted. Our first investor's stock value dropped by 75%. No longer was his investment yielding the dividends he needed to pay for his lifestyle. He sold the stock before it was worthless and used the monies to pay his debts. He was broke! In fact in great debt.

Our second investor likewise sold everything. She was frightened by the crash and wanted out before she had nothing. With the sale she was able to pay off the mortgage and loans. She was now broke.

But the man with the blue chip stayed in the game. He rode the ups and downs of the market knowing that his stock would regain value and even be better than before. In fact he purchased more blue chip at its lowest point and in the end he was better off than before unlike his two friends who were now broke.

In our spiritual life we must ride out the storms, enjoy the ups and downs of our prayer lives confident that if even we cannot remain faithful to God, He will always remain faithful to us and carry us through. The benefits of sticking with our devotedness to Jesus, Mary and Joseph, of never selling out or investing in other "gods", or of persevering in our prayer life with God, are unlimited. Yes there are times when we feel desolation in our prayer and our lives seem to be crashing, but if we stay invested in our trust of Jesus, we will only go higher each time we fall. The market falls but it always recovers and goes higher than it was before. Our spiritual life has its downs but its ups are always greater than the downs so that ultimately we end up on the profitable end – union with Christ. Don't sell out but pray, pray, pray.

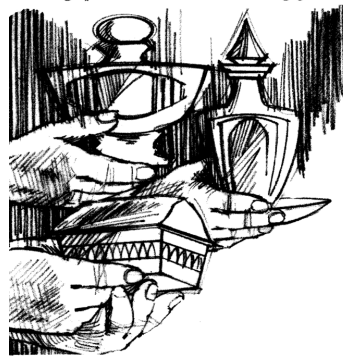

## TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Es tiempo de añadir los reyes magos al pesebre. En 1448 llegaron los pesebres italianos a las iglesias españolas, pero no fue hasta que el Rey Carlos III le regaló un pesebre a su hijo en el siglo XVIII que el uso de pesebres se expandió en los hogares. Desde entonces, el uso de nacimientos llega al continente americano en donde se convierte en la decoración principal para las fiestas navideñas.

Así como en todo país latinoamericano el montaje del Belén es una tradición, lo es también en Venezuela. Con el pesebre venezolano llegan también aguinaldos, parrandas, Misas y patines. ¡Sí! ¡Patines!

Desde la mitad del siglo pasado los venezolanos celebran la época navideña con "patinadas". Estas "patinadas" normalmente se hacen por las mañanas y muchas calles están cerradas a los autos hasta las 8 a.m. para que niños y jóvenes puedan disfrutar de los patines, bicicletas y otros juguetes que les regala el niño Dios.
